Are you prepared for Bushfire Season?

A well prepared home is easier to defend and reduces the risk to surrounding properties. An unprepared home is not only at risk itself, but may also present an increased danger for your neighbours. Use the following lists as a guide to start preparing your home before the start of bushfire season.

Here are some things you can do:

- Clear gutters and roof of leaves, twigs, bark and other debris. Consider installing gutter guards.
- Point LPG cylinder relief valves away from your house.
- Check and maintain firefighting pumps, generators, and water systems.
- Seal gaps in external roof and cladding.
- Remove flammable items away from your home (such as woodpiles, mulch, boxes, hanging baskets, outdoor furniture long dry grass, dead leaves and branches).
- Reduce vegetation along access paths.
- Mow your lawn regularly.
- Trim low-lying branches around your home to a height of two metres from the ground.
- Display house number at road.
- Ensure adequate space for fire trucks to access your home (at least four metres wide and high with turn-around area).
- Gather sufficient personal protective clothing and equipment for all persons and store so that they are readily accessible.
- Prepare your evacuation kit and/or emergency kit.
- Stock your first aid kit.
- Check insurance policies are adequate for home and vehicles.
- •Review and update your Bushfire Survival Plan as a family each year.
- Make a contingency plan.

Bushfires are unpredictable and plans can fail. A contingency plan that identifies your alternate options may save your life if you are caught in a

You need to consider:

- •What will you do if you are away from home (work, school, shopping)?
- •What if your pet is scared and you cannot find them?
- •What if you are home alone?
- *What if you have guests staying with you?
- •What will you do if your travel route is cut off?
- •What will you do if you are trapped in your home?
- •Where will you go if you had planned to stay but it is now unsafe and you need to leave?





Notice that the writer tells us what it is that allows him to have no fear of evil. It is because his Shepherd is with him. He isn't alone, Often in life, we'll find we are most afraid when we are alone. When we have no -one to accompany us in our fear, the shadows seem bigger, the noises seem louder, and our mind tends to run with things that we imagine. When God made Adam, He made Eve from him and for him because

God saw that Adam being alone wasn't good for him. God said "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him." (Gen 2:18). Now, although we may have a spouse, family, and/or friends, they can't always be with us every single place we go. Nor can they necessarily help us with, or know about every problem, worry, fear and concern that goes on in our mind, or is happening at the different times in our life. This is the wonderful comfort that comes from having God as our friend, our comfort, and shepherd. God is always a listening ear, a guiding voice, and a wise confidant in every situation we find ourselves, if we would but listen to Him. He knows about all our problems, watches how we got into them, and knows exactly how to lead us out of them. That is how much He loves us, cares about our health, and wants to lead us out and away from our fears. If we are fear-filled about anything, then we first must check that God is with us. If we have no doubt that He is, then we need to next check that we are close to Him. When we aren't close to Him, we won't recognise His voice when He speaks to us, and we won't be able to find the comfort we are looking for in and during our time of fear. Do you have a relationship with God? Have you asked Him to be your Shepherd? If not, then you will find yourself alone in your fears, and in need of comfort. The comfort you seek will not be found in the bottom of a bottle, or a feeling, or an escape from reality. These things never last, and are proven to never work. The soul of mankind needs a relationship with God. Ask God to shepherd you, lead you, and help you to overcome. God knows us because He made us. Any flaw we have is testament to the fact that we need Him in our life to satisfy those things that we are in lack of. Ask God to be with you, and you need never to fear evil again!

Matt 18:21-35 This parable is a lesson on forgiving. Jesus told it to his disciples when they wanted to understand how to forgive. He tells of a man that owed a lot of money to his master. He wasn't able to pay and was about to lose everything even his own family members. He begged for more time, and his master felt sorry for him. He forgave him of the debt, and told him he owed nothing. The man was very relieved. But then, he went to his masters other servants and demanded them to pay the money that they owed to him. Mind Games...

There's a war that's taking place that we'll not find on any of the nightly news program or social media. It is a war that has destroyed many. And it is the battle for your mind. The battle for your thought life.

And it is a battle we cannot afford to lose. Because what consumes our mind will control our lives. But thankfully, it is a battle that can be won. And, incredibly, God shows us how.

As human beings, we are a threefold being. We are spirit, we have a soul which is our mind, will and emotions, and we live inside of this physical body. We often focus on just two parts of us...our soul and our body. We all certainly do well at feeding our body...three meals a day and, yes, snacks in between. And we've become more aware of the importance of what we feed our minds. But the part of us most neglect is the spiritual.

The Bible is written to us as spiritual food so we have balance in our lives and that we might be as strong spiritually as we are physically and mentally and intellectually.

In 2 Corinthians 4:4 we read what is the devil's agenda, the god of this world's system that is the devil, attempts to blind our minds through unbelief. His purpose for doing so is to block us from receiving and experiencing the strong, overcoming, abundant life that God has made available for us all.

This tells us that the greatest power the devil has is the power of suggestion, of the power of planting a thought in our minds. And there's an example of that recorded in Genesis 3 of Adam and Eve's encounter with the devil. For some reason theologians have blamed Eve for the temptation but, when we read the Bible, it was actually Adam's fault. Eve was deceived but Adam was not deceived. He knew what he was doing.

How was the devil able to do that? Through the power of suggestion. The devil planted in Adam and Eve's minds a thought, a suggestion. Take a look at the beginning of Genesis chapter 3 and see how effective the devil was.

Because the devil (and, yes, he is real) knows if he can control what we think, what we believe and what we say and how we act. And that will determine who we become and what we experience in life. So, it is critical we control where our thoughts go and what thoughts we entertain. Because the devil knows if he can control our thoughts, he can control us.

How do we know what God's thoughts are? Well, we have a book called the Bible. And it's full of God's thoughts. And His thoughts are nothing like the devil's. If you want to know what God thinks about you, open the Bible and look inside. Jeremiah 29:11 tells of God's thoughts toward us, For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

So, we want to fill our mind with God's thoughts found in His Word. Because it's only His thoughts about us that can successfully counter the devil's treacherous suggestions.

In fact, Paul also tells us in Romans 12:2 how our mind can be radically changed. He says, Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. There is such power in this verse.

We'll talk about this more next month because we all need healthy minds and win the battle for our minds.

True transformation in our lives comes when we start to change our thinking.


