Anzac stands for Australian and New Zealand Army Corps, soldiers in those forces became known as Anzacs. Anzac Day marks the anniversary of the first major military action fought by Australian and New Zealand forces during the First World War.

Today Australians recognise Anzac Day as a day of national remembrance. Commemorative services are held across Australia at Dawn, time of the original landing and later service where servicemen and servicewomen march through the streets of cities and towns, like Millmerran. The main service in Millmerran will commence with a march down Campbell Street from the Gore Highway ending at Anzac Park for the formal ceremony and laying of wreaths at the Cenotaph in Anzac Park.

Anzac Day is when the community comes together to reflect on the many different meanings of war, and to remember.
