Signs have been ordered so if you sight a koala and would like a sign to place on roadside to raise awareness of their existence in the area, please let me know and I can get a sign to you.

Thanks to Tennille from Wildlife Empire for hosting a couple of workshops focusing on koala and other native wildlife health and wellbeing.

Vegetation and weed management has been carried out on properties where koalas have been known to inhabit. Cool burns have been a great success creating more diverse and healthy landscapes that are safer from wildfires.







# PRAYER - What should I say?

To continue on from last month, we'll remain in the same passage (Matt 6:5-7). In this part of Christ's sermon to His disciples He first tells them what not to say, or rather who not to be like - a hypocrite. To this day nobody likes a hypocrite, but in this sense of a hypocrite being used here, the disciples were not to stand in public and pray out loud just for the purposes of being heard. This isn't the right essence of prayer. Prayer is a heart to heart with God from our own self and at times on the behalf of others. When we pray, our words should come from our heart with our thoughts on who we are praying to & on who or what we are praying for. This is why the next verse tells us to go to a private place. A place where nobody can hear what we are saying. Then when God answers our prayer we will praise Him even more because we know He

answered that private heart to heart time we had with Him over a matter. A time that only He & I know about.

Jesus then goes on in the next verse, which is our verse above, to explain to us what we are to say. He says to not use vain repetitions. This means no repetitiveness. To not use the same "prayer", or words, over & again. Things like reading a prayer from off a piece of paper that someone else has written. Or using the same prayer for that same occasion every time. Why would we read a prayer that someone else has written when we can have the wonderful privilege of communicating with God from our own heart. God would much rather hear what we have to say than to hear us vainly repeat what someone else has said and call it prayer. Now, some people like to use written prayers that others have used for years because they say they don't know what to say. But prayer isn't meant to be a professional skill. It is simply communicating what is on our heart to God via our lips. Hearing our self pray to God actually helps us to understand what is on our heart. Christ says that to use vain repetitions is something that the heathen do. The heathen are those that do not hold to Christianity. Do we really want to sound like a heathen when we pray? We have this desire to speak to God, and then we pull out a prayer that is

close to what we want to say, or we think it sounds better than our own words, and believe that will please God? Of course it won't. God wants to hear from individuals. God loves to hear from a heart that has things to say, to ask, or thank Him for. Nothing is going to sound any better or fancier than the "mumbled jargon" that we believe we are going to say. Practice in your closet. Get used to speaking with God in private. One can always tell how much a person prays in private by how well they pray in public. It is learned behaviour. So, may we not worry so much about how we sound or the fancy words on pages out there that use religious phrases and hold to them as better than our own. The last thing we want to do is for God to not hear our prayer because of our "much speaking", or our "vain repetitions", because we sound like a "heathen". Think about what you want to say God, and come into His presence with reverence. Rremove the distractions and talk to Him. Thank Him. Praise Him. Request of Him according to His will & wait. It is far better to sound like a child of God than a repetitive hypocrite.

# Sunday 23rd March 2025 will be a day to be remembered in our little community. This was the day when a Long Tan Memorial Cross was unveiled at the Wylahra Grove Progress Association Community Hall Grounds.

It was no coincidence that this eventuated on that day. March 23rd, 1972, marked the date when the last Australian combat troops returned home from the Vietnam War, signifying the end of Australia's active involvement in the conflict on the ground.

\*The Long Tan Memorial Cross is a symbol of our heritage and our sacrifice.\*

Erected in memory of the 18 young men who died in one of the most intense and dramatic actions of the Vietnam War, the cross has been adopted by veterans to symbolise the 520 young men we lost and the 3,000 that were wounded in that war. The Long Tan Memorial Cross has been used by Vietnam veterans to remember and honour their dead, alongside their fight for recognition of the living. Veterans considered national recognition of their war service was not forthcoming. The practice of erecting replica Long Tan Memorial Crosses became not only a memorial practice by Vietnam veterans, but a way to gain public recognition of their service, and in doing so, negotiating their place within the Anzac tradition.

We thank God and reverently remember those who gave their lives for our country and those of us who were spared to return. We thank Russell and Ron for constructing the memorial cross, thanks also to Ron, Paul, Jason, Wayne, Steve and Cameron for the preparations and installing of such.

We wholeheartedly thank all those who attended or supported this day. We especially thank Members of 6 Battalion RAR, Vietnam Veterans and all ex serviceman and women and their families who attended.

Thanks to Jason, Joe and Krystal for the Long Tan Honour Shield, excellent work.
